

2019 GEO Symposium

Poster Session Guidelines

A new feature in 2019 will be the opportunity for GEO Work Programme activities to describe their activities, their 2017-2019 results, and their plans for 2020-2022 in poster format.

The posters will be displayed on large rolling stands that will be located just outside the meeting room. There will be a formal opening of the poster session at the first coffee break on the morning of 27 May, following which Symposium attendees will be encouraged to browse the posters and to speak with representatives of the activities who may be present.

Eligibility

Space for displaying the posters is limited. Preference will be given first to GEO Community Activities (especially those not invited to present during the Symposium sessions), then to Flagships, Initiatives, Foundational Tasks and Working Groups in the GEO Work Programme.

Posters from organizations involved in the GEO Work Programme may be accepted if space allows.

Format

Posters should be no larger than A0 format (about 48 x 36 inches). Landscape orientation is recommended, although the stands can accommodate portrait orientation if required.

On-Site Printing

On-site printing is available at a cost of 50 CHF per sheet, payable in advance. Print-ready files must be received by the GEO Secretariat no later than end of day 20 May 2019. Please inform the Secretariat in advance, ideally at the time of submitting your expression of interest, if you wish to make use of this service.

Poster Set Up and Removal

Posters not requiring on-site printing by the GEO Secretariat may be brought to the site by attendees and set up at the time of registration. Please ask GEO Secretariat staff at the registration desk for assistance.

Representatives from the activities or organizations displaying the posters are responsible for their removal from the display stands before the end of the Symposium.
