Why National GEO for Kenya?

Standardization of Processes and Systems

 Development and adoption of common data standards, data sharing protocols, and interoperable systems which allows for seamless data exchange, integration, and analysis

Collaboration and Knowledge Sharing

 Provides a platform for sharing knowledge, experiences, and best practices by bringing together experts, practitioners, researchers, and stakeholders resulting in consolidation of efforts, collaboration and improved decision-making

Policy and Governance Support

 Facilitates extensive dialogue between policymakers, researchers, and stakeholders to provide valuable inputs and expertise to support policy development, implementation, and evaluation

Public Engagement and Sensitization

 Possibility of organizing joint outreach programs, educational campaigns, and citizen science initiatives involving the public in data collection, monitoring, and analysis to promote environmental stewardship

Capacity Building and Technology Transfer

 Joint professional development and technology transfer programs to ensure EO practitioners are equipped with requisite skills to effectively utilize EO information, technologies and data analysis techniques in support of decision-making process
