

Executive Committee Members 2026

As approved at the GEO-21 Plenary.

The Executive Committee members are a representative subset of the membership of GEO caucuses. The Executive Committee consists of 18 GEO Members based on the following geographic distribution: Africa (4), Americas (4), Asia and Oceania (4), Commonwealth of Independent States (CIS) (2) and Europe (4).

Executive Committee members, including those members serving as Co-Chairs, are nominated through regional caucuses. Based on the conclusions of the regional caucuses and further consultations as necessary, the Director presents a slate of nominees, including those nominated to serve as Co-Chairs, to the Plenary for its approval. Upon approval, Executive Committee members will serve a term of up to two years.

For 2026, the following GEO Members’ 2-year term is due to expire:

The Rules of Procedure Task Force, established under the authority of the Executive Committee, proposed amendments to the GEO Rules of Procedure affecting the number of seats allocated to the Americas and Africa caucuses. These amendments were set out in document GEO-20-5.2 and approved by the GEO-20 Plenary in May 2025.

The changes take effect at GEO-21 Plenary. Accordingly, additional Executive Committee members have been nominated by the relevant regional caucuses to serve on the Executive Committee in 2026:
